

UNIVANCE Green Purchasing Guidelines

1. Environmental Philosophy

UNIVANCE CORPORATION recognizes that environmental protection is a critical global issue, and we carefully consider global environmental protection in all aspects of our corporate activities.

2. Environmental Policy

Univance group pursues earth-friendly manufacturing practices (monotsukuri) and harmonizes between corporate activities and global environment in order to hand over a better world for future generations.

- 1) Observe rules and promote earth-friendly corporate activities.
- 2) Minimize the use of resources and energies.
- 3) Identify environmental risks and continuously prevent them.

3. Green Purchasing

We promote environmental protection activities in the supply chain by committing to purchasing products, parts, raw materials, secondary materials, etc. from environmentally friendly suppliers.

4. Environmental Management System

In order to construct the Environmental Management System, obtaining certifications of ISO14001 or equivalent Environmental Management Systems (KES, Eco Action 21, Eco Stage, Environmental Management System Standard, or etc.) are recommended.

For survey of suppliers' efforts regarding the certification obtainment and self-declaration of conformity, we would appreciate to cooperate submitting the certification obtainment survey and the plan (once a year.)

5. Survey of Environmentally Hazardous Substances

When requested by a customer or deemed necessary by UNIVANCE, we may ask our suppliers' cooperation of surveys regarding environmentally hazardous substances.

- 1) Data of all components used in products shall be input and reported by IMDS.
- 2) Complete survey of containing substances that are subject to the European RoHS Directive.
- 3) Submit SDS (Safety Data Sheet).
- 4) Respond to conflict minerals.

6. Reduction of CO₂ emissions

UNIVANCE is working to reduce CO₂ emissions by 1% each year compare to the previous year. We ask our suppliers to also assist in this effort.

- 1) As part of our suppliers' environmental protection activities, we would ask that suppliers voluntarily grasp its CO₂ emissions and performs reduction activities.
- 2) We may ask our suppliers to report on CO₂ reduction results.
